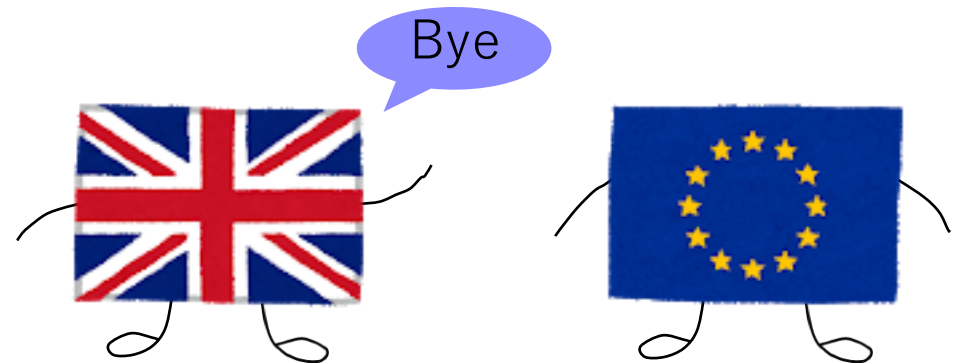

A public vote was held on 23/6/2016.



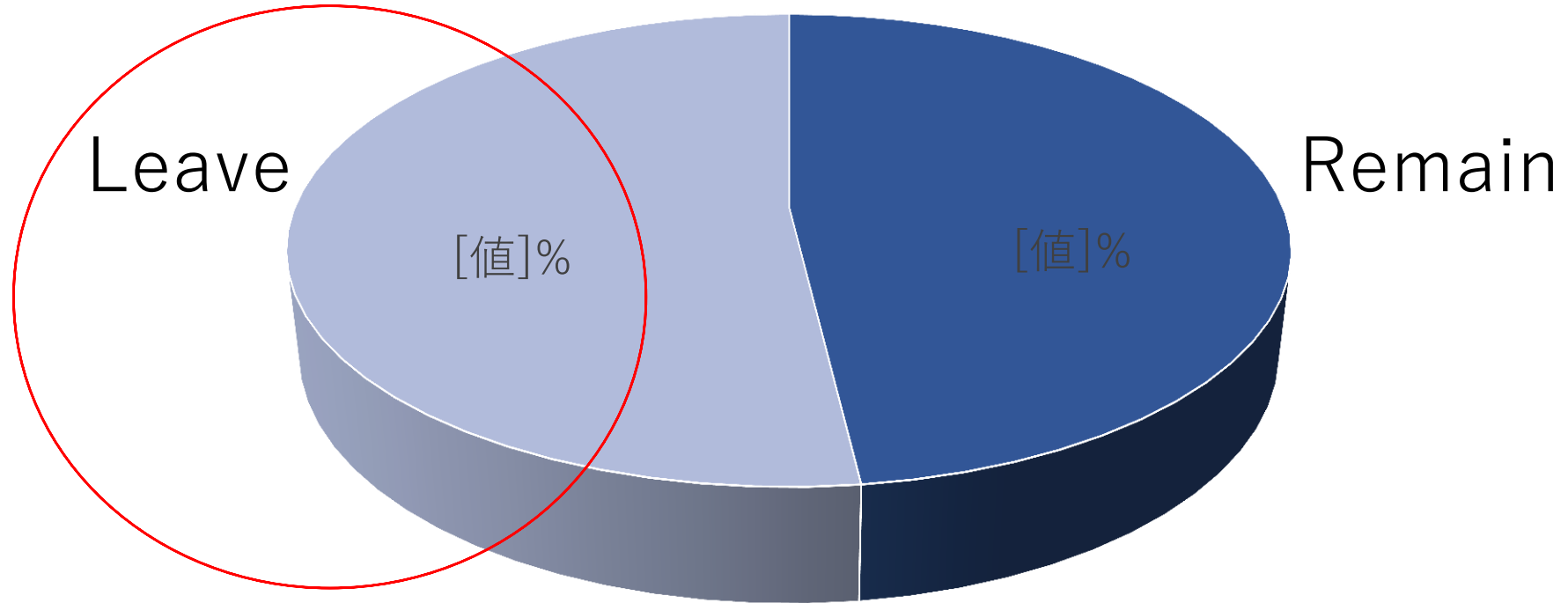
Leave?

29 March → the ~~negotiation~~ → 31 October

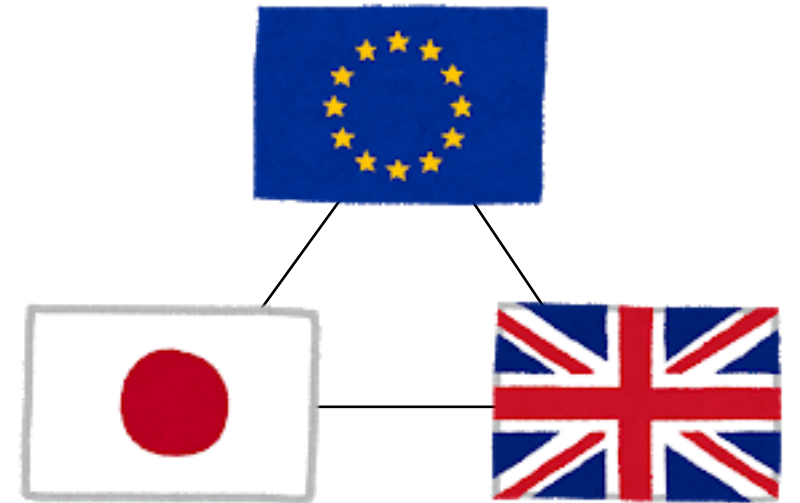

>300,000 foreigners could be allowed to work

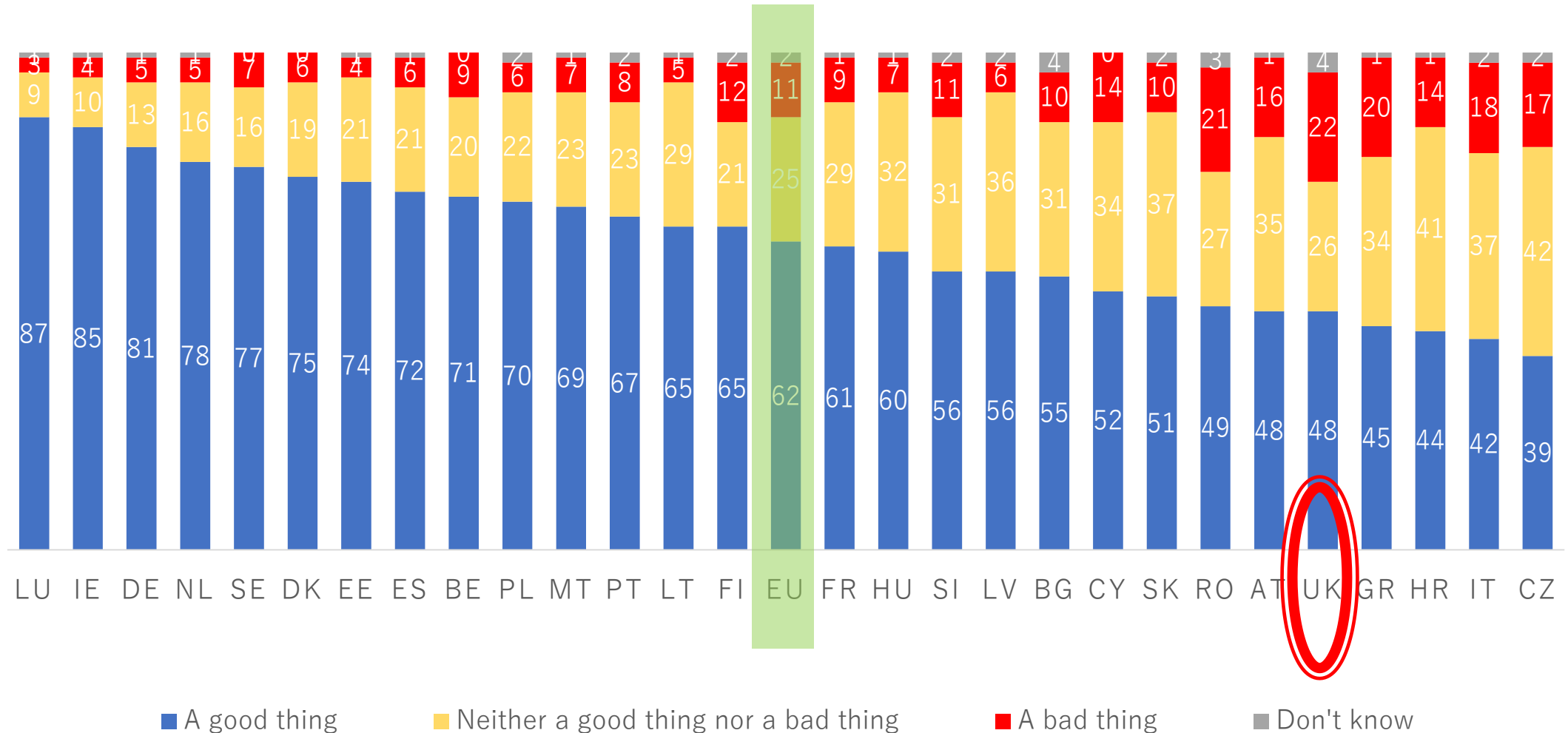
two new visa categories

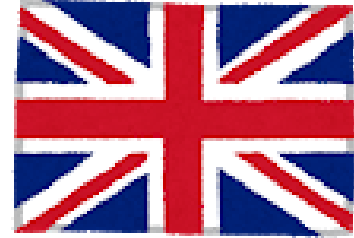


# Merit

to accept**

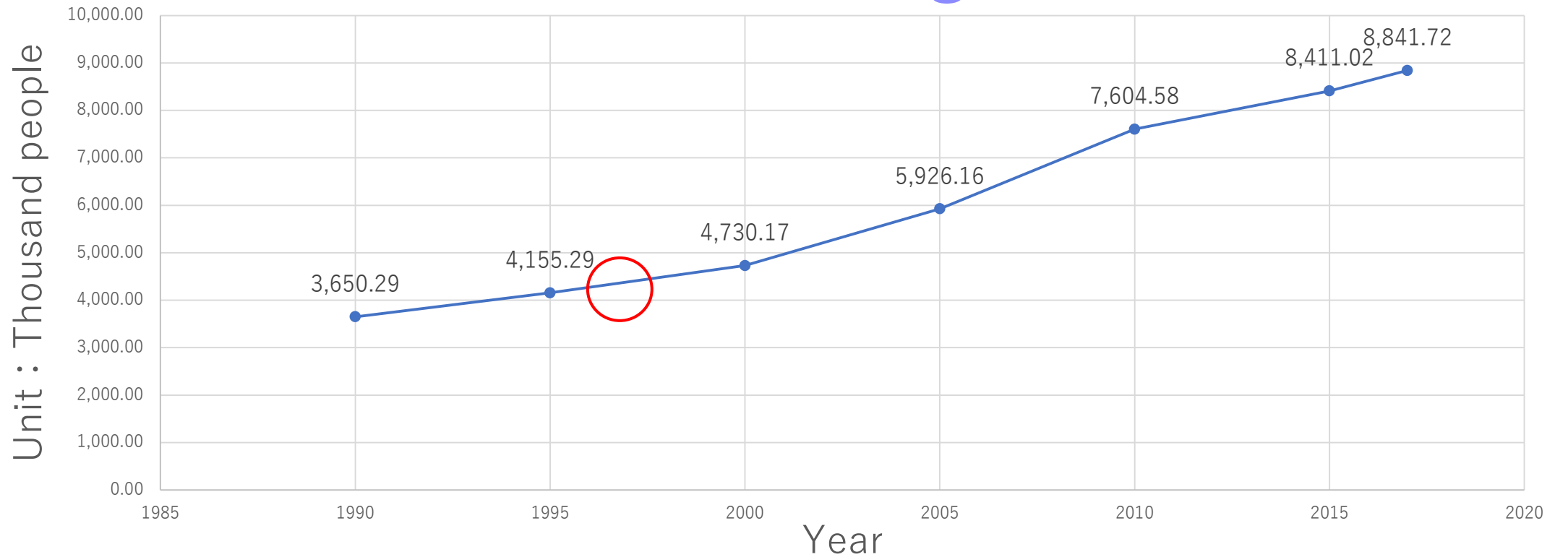
There is such a merit !

# Merit Immigration

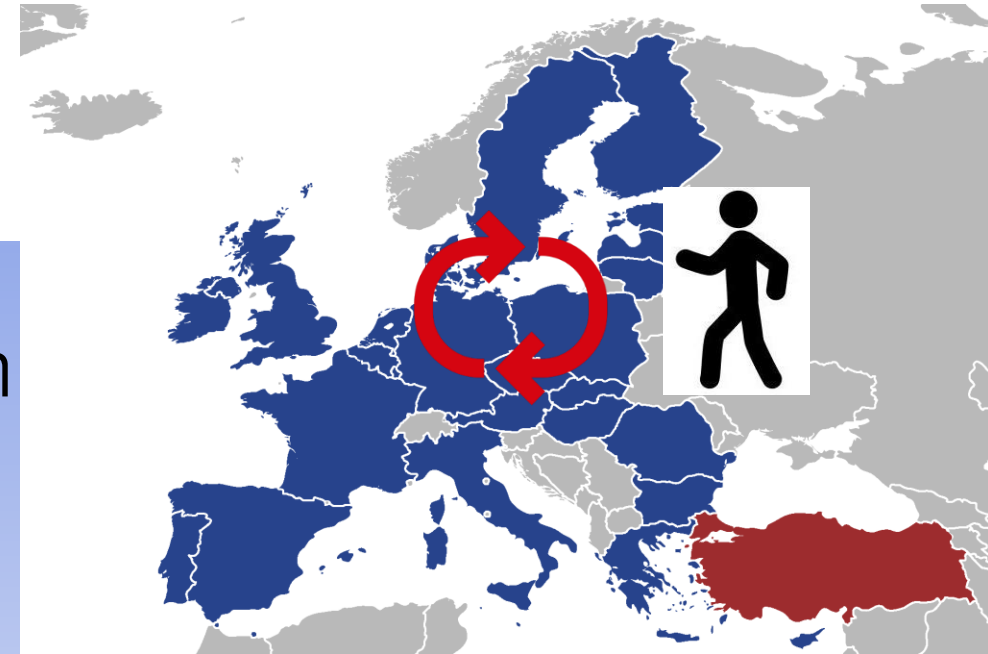
1997 : Abolition of border inspection

**These are solved !!?**

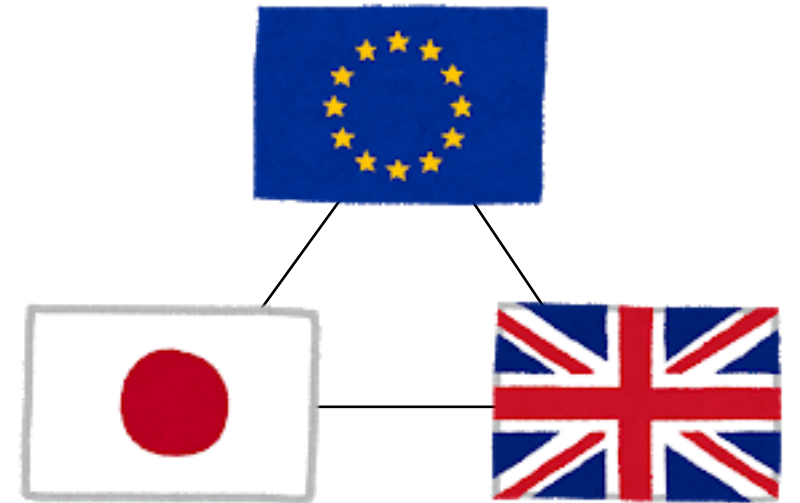

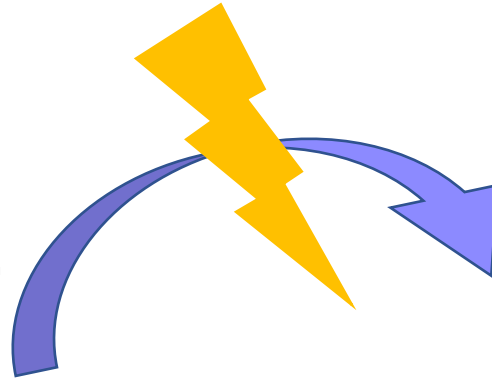

# Tariff



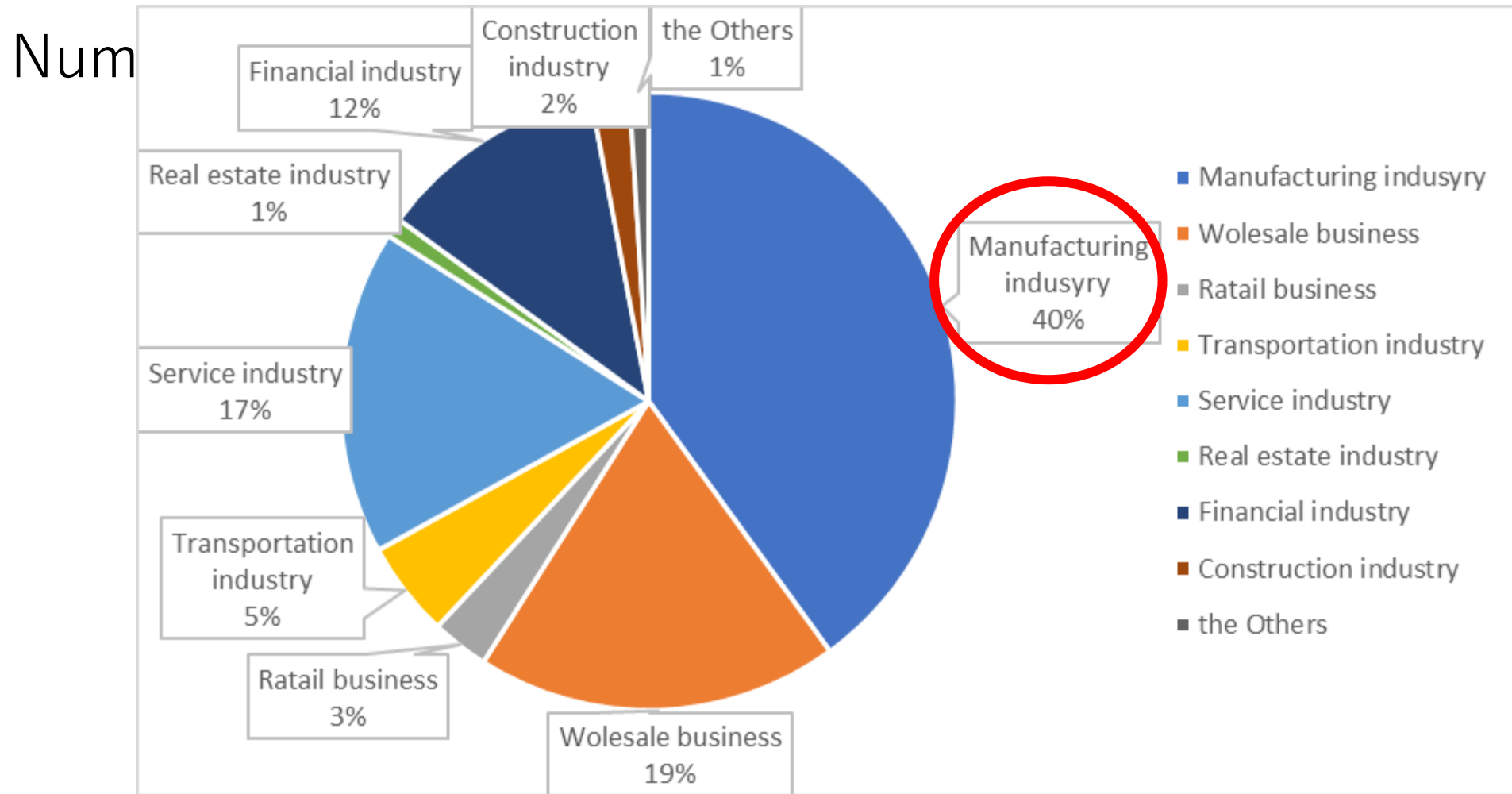
Make products in the UK

—Impact on Japanese Companies—



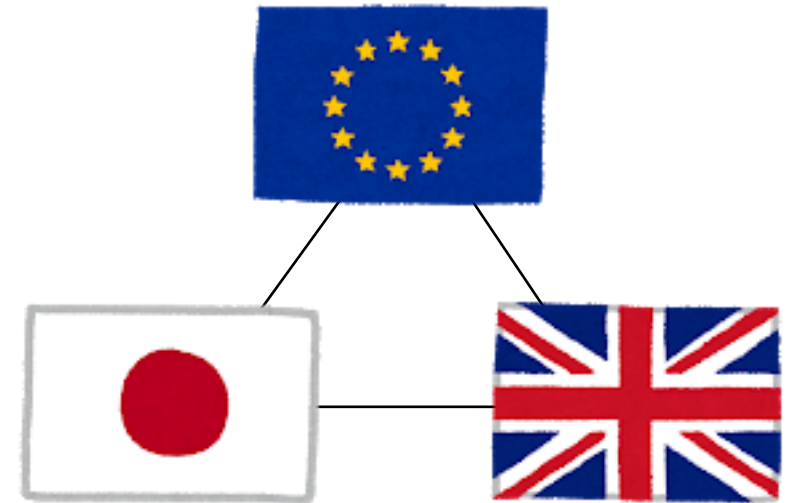
Percentage of companies by industry (June, 2016 researched by *teikokubanku*)

Companies and factories may move to other countries which causes

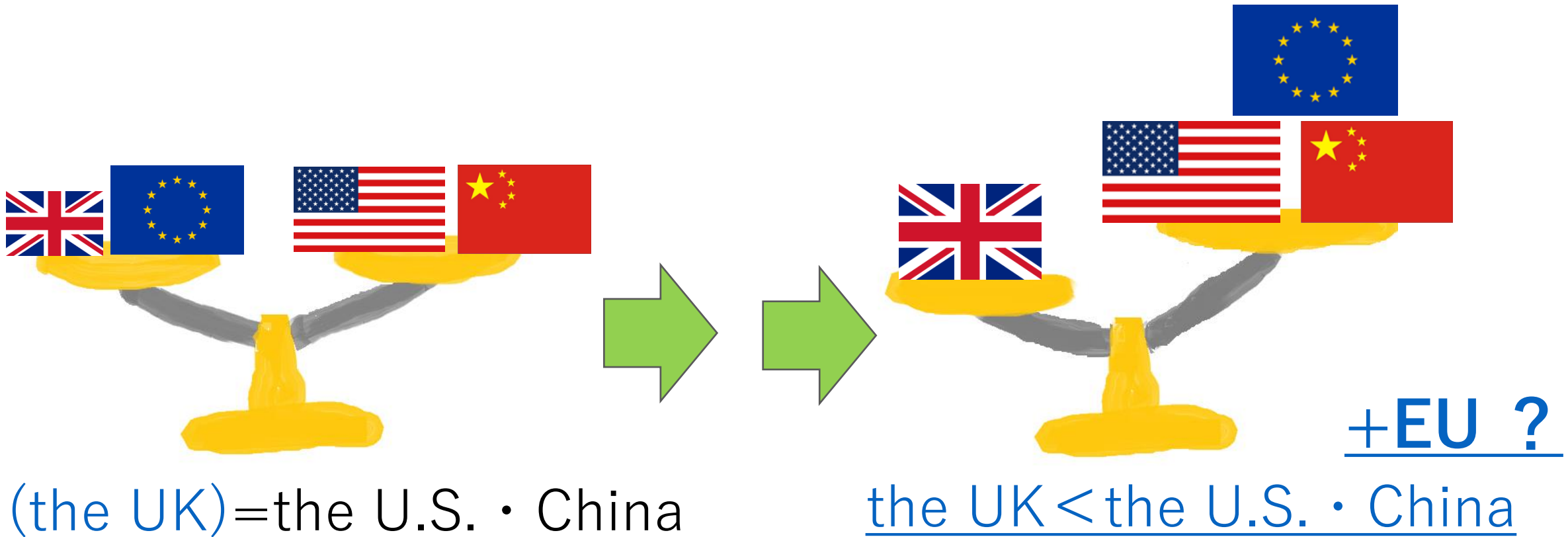
→unemployment rate increase.

→influence GDP and economy.



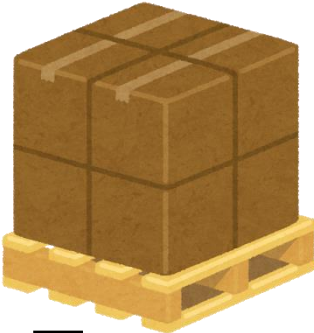
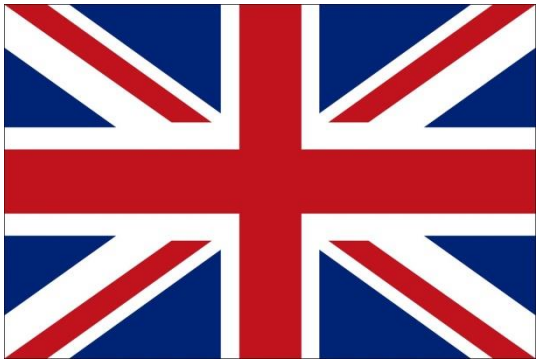
# Consideration

→ The UK might be obliged to pay tariff by some countries.

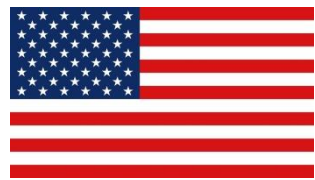

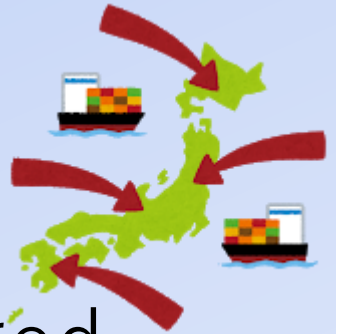
# Consideration

Wonder if Japan exit TPP like Brexit ??

[1] Many cheap items effect Japanese products.  
Especially, agricultural products will be damaged.

[2] Many foreigners will come as a labors.  
Some Japanese may oppose for accepting so many.

→ **but, Japanese wouldn't request to leave TPP.**



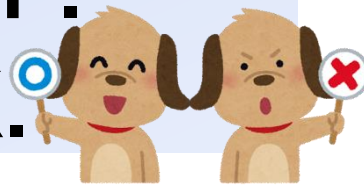
# Consideration

Because...

[1] Consumers always want cheap items.  
Farmers market had been decreasing.

[2] Japan can't manage economy without foreign workers.

→ **Most people think that it is good to remain TPP.  
National division wouldn't happen like the UK.**





# Consideration

- Consider measures to guard by economy effect of import items.
- Keep good relationship with Australia, Canada, Vietnam, NZ...
- Japan have to make systems not to have trouble between foreign workers and Japanese.
